



## **Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (HEERF II)**

On December 27, 2020, the President signed the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) (P.L. 116-260). This new law gives the U.S. Department of Education (Department) approximately \$22.7 billion to distribute to institutions of higher education in order to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus through the HEERF. This law has some similarities—as well as important differences—from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) (P.L. 116–136) that was enacted on March 27, 2020. The grant programs authorized under section 314(a)(1) of the CRRSAA are referred to below as the “(a)(1) programs” and their funds as “(a)(1) funds.”

The following information is reported for the period, **7/1/2021 - 9/30/21**

(1) Acknowledgment that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA to provide Emergency Aid Grants to Students.

(2) The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA **\$104,002.00**

(3) The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA as of the date of submission **09/30/2021, \$104,002.00.**

(4) The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Grants to Students under the CRRSAA, **122 students.**

(5) The total number of students who received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA, **118 students.**

(6) The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they received under the CRRSAA. (see attached form below)

- Student must complete application provided via Email.
- Student must have completed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the 2020-2021 or 2021/2022 year and have an official Expected Family Contribution (EFC) on file.
- Student must be currently attending at the time the application is submitted.
